- Passed military airport protection legislation
- Protected property owner's water rights
- Defeated onerous real estate licensing regulations
- Defeated legislation that would have enacted a sales tax on REALTOR® commissions
- Municipalities *are now required to provide water status* in rural or non-Active Management Areas of our state
- Continued to fight to defeat a state *sales tax on services*
- Prevented outside organizations from obtaining licensee *email addresses* from the ADRE
- Made clarifications to the *Employer Sanction* law effecting independent contractors
- Advocated reasonable *water rights* disclosure and availability
- Maintained statewide permission for display of *for sale signs* in HOAs
- Passed *mandatory licensing* of loan originators
- Defeated *onerous water legislation*
