CODE OF ETHICS ENFORCEMENT

- 2. The enforcement of the NAR Code of Ethics is achieved through an ethics complaint process.
- The NAR Code of Ethics and Arbitration Manual (CEAM) sets forth the rules and procedures related to REALTOR[®]
 Code of Ethics complaints.
