Modifies the time in which a landlord would have to hold a tenant's personal property from 21 days to 14 days after abandonment or failure to comply with the rental agreement.

### **What This Victory Means** for You...

Reduces the length of time a landlord would have to hold a tenant's personal property after abandonment or failure to comply with the rental agreement from 21 days to 14 days. The bill further established that the landlord has no duty to store perishable items and authorizes the landlord to use direction when removing animals from the property.

Allows real estate brokers and sales persons licensed by ADRE to sell manufactured homes and mobile homes outside of a mobile home park.

Allows a licensed real estate agent or licensed real estate broker to sell new manufactured homes if the licensed real estate agent or broker is acting as an agent for a licensed manufactured housing dealer and the dealer is responsible for filing all the required paperwork and submitting the required fees on the sale of the home.
