## **COVID-19 Vaccine Phase**

### **By Arizona County**

Arizona COVID-19 vaccine is allocated through local and tribal health jurisdictions. Due to the current limited initial supply of vaccine, Arizona counties will be utilizing a <u>vaccine prioritization phased approach</u>. The map below shows which phase each county is currently vaccinating. Please note that in order to be vaccinated, **you will need to be a member of the current phase**, schedule an appointment, and provide appropriate identification once you arrive at the vaccination site.

- Phase 1C Adults 65 and Older, Adults of Any Age with High-Risk Medical Conditions, Adults Living in Congregate Settings, Remaining 1A & 1B
