

OF REALTORS.





1953

Incorporated in Arizona.



1962

Amended Arizona Constitution to
allow real estate professionals
to draft contracts (Article 26).



1975

Arizona REALTORS® approved and began distribution
of its first Residential Purchase Contract which was
two pages with escrow instructions.



1987

Arizona REALTORS® produced a more
inclusive Residential Purchase Contract
which was 6 pages and was copyrighted.

1988

Approved creation of Arizona
REALTORS® Legal Hotline.



1995

Arizona REALTORS® began
making its forms library
available to members on
disk via ZipForm.



2000

Helped pass legislation requiring
that home inspectors be licensed.



2001

Instituted statewide
professional standards.

2008

For a second time amended Arizona Constitution
to prohibit transfer tax on sale of real property.



2020

Successfully lobbied Governor Ducey's
office to include REALTORS® as essential
workers during the COVID-19 pandemic.

2018

For a third time amended
Arizona Constitution to
prohibit tax on services.
