2022 LEGISLATIVE BILLS & POSITIONS



HB2101

- ✓ Support
- ✓ Signed by the Governor

Protects Arizona from a deregulated utility market and ensures that Arizona will have a reliable and affordable grid as we continue to experience historic growth.

HB2747

- ✓ Support
- ✓ Signed by the Governor

Establishes disclosure requirements for wholesale buyers and sellers of residential real property.

HB2172

- ✓ Support
- ✓ Signed by the Governor

Codifies statutes to support real estate teams' ability to hire licensees as W-2 employees, pending Broker approval and other conditions.

SB1168

- Neutral
- ✓ Signed by the Governor

Relates to the regulation of Short-Term Rentals. The Arizona REALTORS® testified as neutral on the bill to voice concerns over any amendments that would impose caps or limits on how many short-term rentals could be allowed in a city or town, which the REALTORS® would oppose.

HB2674

- ✓ Support
- ✓ Signed by the Governor

Established the Housing Supply Study Committee consisting of stakeholders and experts, including the Arizona REALTORS®, passed through the Senate almost unanimously. The committee will evaluate solutions to address the housing crisis before introducing them next session.

SB1116

- ✓ Support
- ✗ Failed in Senate

Would have repealed the residential rental transaction privilege tax (TPT) but unfortunately died on the Senate floor in the closing days of the 2022 legislative session. While the bill received strong support from both sides of the aisle and successfully passed out of the House of Representatives, it failed by a very slim margin in the Senate.

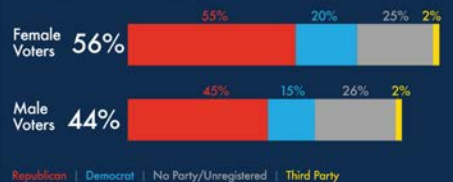
